This agreement has been drafted in line with government guidance and with the specific purpose of keeping all learners safe and free from infection of the coronavirus. Access to school is dependent on the signing of this agreement by student and parent.

1. My child must enter via the U Block gates every day that they are in. Arrival times must be adhered to and students should not arrive any earlier than 15 minutes before the session or arrive late. Any latecomers may not be admitted unless by prior agreement with the senior leadership team.
2. I will not send my child into school if they appear unwell. If my child presents at the gate with symptoms or discloses that a member of their family has symptoms they will be refused entry and sent home. If this becomes clear during the day, I will be contacted to collect my child.
3. If my child presents with symptoms, the school will advise I get a test. If the test is positive, I will ensure that my child self-isolates for 7 days, with members of the household doing so for 14 days. If the test is negative, I will ensure the school are shown the result before my child returns to school.
4. If my child has symptoms but is not able to be tested, I will isolate them for 7 days.
5. As a condition of my child coming back into school, I will be contactable throughout the day for health and safety reasons. If my job means I may not get to the phone easily, I will ensure the school has **at least three current or up-to-date contact names and numbers**.
6. If my child presents as unwell whilst at school, for whatever reason, they will remain in a quarantined area until I have been contacted. It will then be my responsibility to collect my child from school or provide school with authorisation that my child can make their own way home.
7. I will ensure my child attends in their school uniform, minus blazer and tie, with long hair tied back.
8. My child will arrive equipped to learn, with KO file, stationery and planner as well as a strong bag.
9. In the interests of hygiene, my child must wash their hands upon entry into school grounds and regularly throughout the day. Parents are encouraged to provide a hand sanitiser for their child to use.
10. I understand my child will be escorted and will only be allowed to enter specific designated areas of the building.
11. I understand it is expected that students engage with work provided fully and complete all tasks to the best of their ability. If my child refuses to work or disrupts others, I understand I will be contacted and asked to collect them.
12. I will support the rule that my child must observe a 2 metre distance from other students and staff. This includes at unstructured times. There should be no physical contact between students.
13. Due to the shortened length of the school day, we do not intend to provide a meal service. Students entitled to FSM will continue to receive a weekly voucher. Students are encouraged to bring a snack if they wish.
14. If my child is expected to be absent from school, I will ring the usual absence line and record their name and reason, plus how long I think the absence will be.
