Year 11 Revision Programme

Dear Student/Parent,

I am writing to share the revision programme we have planned to support Year 11 students during the period between now and the end of the exams.

Key Dates

Each student must continue to attend school every day until his/her last exam has been completed. For most students, this will be **Thursday 23rd June**.

Until Wednesday 15th June, students will follow their normal timetable, attending all lessons, unless of course, there is an exam or planned revision session. When students have lessons in subjects which they have finished the course, they must take revision materials from other subjects.

From Thursday 16th June, the normal timetable will be suspended, and **Year 11 students should only attend school when they have a revision session or exam**. Students will still be in school every day up to 23rd June, but may arrive or leave at different times than usual. Details can be seen in the attached programme.

The Revision Programme

The attached programme includes;

- The dates and times of **exams** (shaded **grey**)
- Revision sessions we will provide **before school** (**orange**)
- Revision sessions we will provide **after school** (**yellow**)
- Revision sessions **during the school day** which differ from timetabled lessons (**green**)
- Revision sessions at weekends or during school holidays (**blue**)

As this is such a detailed document, we will provide students with a simplified **weekly bulletin** to remind them of arrangements for the forthcoming week. For some of the revision sessions outside of school hours, students will need to sign up to book a place. Subject teachers will advise them how to do this.

NB each student has also been issued with his/her own **personalised exams timetable**.

We strongly advise that students attend as many of the sessions before and after school or during weekends/holidays as possible. In previous years, we have found that the students who participated in these additional sessions gained the best results.

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Revision at home

Please encourage your child to revise regularly at home. Students who achieve the best results spend, on average, **two hours** per day revising at home.

Study Club

Please make use of the Study Club, which will be available after school **until 4.30pm every day** until the exams have finished. This is ideal for students who may get distracted from revision outside of school.

Thanks in advance for your support. By continuing to work together for the last few weeks, we can ensure that the best possible exam results are achieved in the summer.
