Dear Student/Parent,

I am writing to share the revision programme we have planned to support Year 11 students during the period between now and the end of the exams.

Attendance

Please note that there will be no study leave. Students must continue to attend school every day until his/her last exam has been completed. Experience has shown that students who do this achieve better exams results.

The Revision Programme

The attached programme includes;

- The dates and times of **exams (grey)**
- Revision sessions we will provide **before school (orange)**
- Revision sessions we will provide **after school (yellow)**
- Revision sessions **during the school day** which differ from timetabled lessons (**green**)
- Revision sessions at weekends or during school holidays (**blue**)

Please be aware that some exams which only involve one or two students have not been included in this programme e.g. additional languages. However, these are shown on the **personalised exams timetable that has been given to every student.**

We strongly advise that students attend as many of the sessions before and after school or during weekends/holidays as possible. In previous years, we have found that the students who participated in these additional sessions achieved better grades.

Revision at Home

At this stage, students should be revising at home for **two hours** per day, on average. The **Y11 Study Club** in the library will be available **until 4.30pm** each day for students who may get distracted from revision outside of school.

By continuing to work together for the last few weeks, we can ensure that the best possible exam results are achieved in the summer.
