## Bike safety

From Monday 24th February, we are launching a Cycling Agreement, and from this date, if your child chooses to cycle to school they must wear a helmet, provided by yourself, and a wristband, which we will supply (chargeable if lost). The roads around school have become busier in recent months, so if you wish to provide your child with a helmet to wear prior to the 'switch date' we would encourage that. After the switch date, helmets and wristbands, as well as a serviceable bike lock, will be mandatory. Details will follow on this plan.
